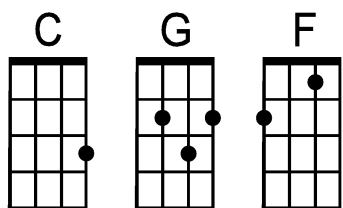


Can't You Hear My Heartbeat? (Key of C)
