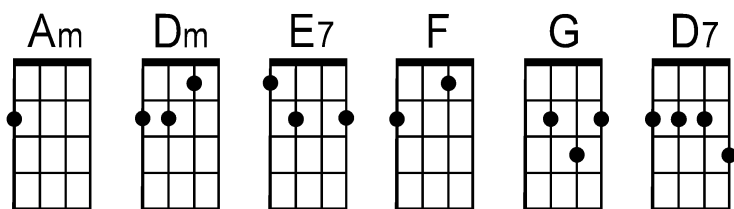


Mysterious Mose

 A7 D G7
 But I'll bet-cha he'll get-cha if you don't look out for him

Am Dm E7 Am\ (----Hold----)
 For every time you hear a shriek, every-body knows

Very slowly
softly Am Dm Am
 If someone whistles, "Whooo - oo!"

FAST E7 Am\ E7\ Am\
