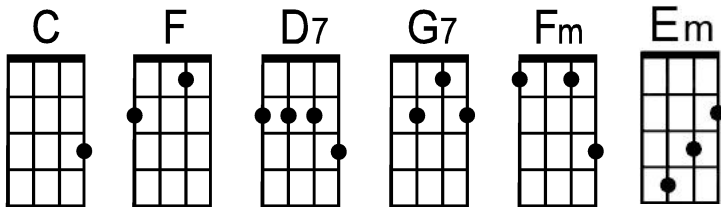


Yes, We Have No Bananas
